

Maplecrest Recap:

The MSGA's first event of 2010, the John Pavlos Classic, was held at Maplecrest C.C. in Goshen on May 12th. The turnout was 112 players, the largest in more than two years. Sixteen new members played in their first MSGA tournament. The weather was very cool with temperatures in the 50's with drizzle and rain for most of the day. The golf course was in great condition, but with some standing water later in the day. The sloping and undulating greens were tough especially with the rain. Overall with handicaps, eight players bested par of 71 and three matched par.

In the Individual Medal competition, overall low gross went to Rich Stone with a five over par 76, an excellent score considering the conditions. Mike Basney was a shot back with a 77. Paul Baldoni, Rich Stone and Taylor Seward tied for low net with 69's, with Paul winning the tie-breaker.

In the Skins competition, multiple winners were Bill Hehemann and Taylor Seward with two skins each. In total, there were 16 skins in the four flights. Congratulations to prize winners in all the flights, which can be found on the Tournament Results tab.

In the season long Brady Cup competition, Mike Gilpin has the early lead with 425 points. Mike Miles is second with 400 points. Four others are within 100 points of the lead. The standings are shown on the Brady Cup tab.
