

Morris Park C. C. Recap:

The MSGA's tenth and final tournament of 2010, an Individual Medal event, was held at Morris Park C. C. in South Bend, Indiana on September 27th. The turnout was excellent with 107 players participating. It was the MSGA's fifth tournament at Morris Park over the years. The Morris Park staff did a great job with excellent service for lunch, golf and dinner.

The weather was a perfect fall day with plenty of sunshine, a light breeze and temperatures near 70. The golf course was in terrific shape, but played very difficult. The greens were in wonderful shape and extremely fast, leading to lots of comments about plenty of three-putts. The fairways and rough were also in excellent shape with very little damage from the hot and humid summer. Overall with handicaps, only six players bested par of 70 while five others matched par.

In the Individual Medal competition, the overall low gross winner was Jerry Giolitto with a two over par 72, which included three birdies. Kent Kaeppler and F. X. Gartland tied for second with 79's. Art Branco was the overall low net winner with an excellent five under par 65. Geoff Snyder was two shots back with a net 67. F. X. Gartland, Jim Wiggins, Mike Lake and Norm Drenten each had net 69's.

In the Skins competition, Joe Juday, Scott Dolfman and Bill Hehemann were multiple winners with two skins each. In total, there were 22 skins in the four flights. Congratulations to prize winners in all the flights, a list of which can be found on the Tournament Results tab.

In the season-long Brady Cup competition, Mike Gilpin repeated as champion, finishing first with 2025 points. Bruce Fisher was second with 1935 points and Walt Ailes third with 1810 points.
