The MSGA's third event of 2011 was held at Mystic Hills G.C. in Culver, IN on June 6th.

The turnout was an excellent 101 players. The weather was forecast for hot temperatures and possible storms during the afternoon, but except for the very hot mid 90's temperatures, the day turned out to be sunny and breezy with a few high clouds. The biggest issues were the undulating greens and the very thick and sometimes deep rough. The course placed a premium on keeping the ball out of the rough. Even with the fast greens and tough rough, scores were very good. Overall with handicaps, fifteen players bested par of 71 and eight others matched par.

In the Individual Medal competition, overall low gross winner was Ken Bisson with a fine seven over par 78. Dick Butler and Fred Mitchell tied for second with 79's. Jay Harrison and Art Bartholomew were another shot back with 80's. Art Bartholomew was the overall low net winner with an outstanding eleven under par net 60, which included 12 net birdies and five net pars. Bill SanGiacomo and Gil Vayhinger tied for second with net 66's. Dick Butler and Jay Harrison were another shot back with net 67's.

In the Skins competition, Ahmed Kashani was the only multiple winner with two skins. In total, there were 20 skins in the four flights. In the Closest-to-the-Pin contest, Harry Pakish's shot on the 156 yard 12<sup>th</sup> hole was the closest at one foot, seven inches.
