Meadow Valley G. C. Recap: June 25, 2012

The MSGA's fourth tournament of 2012 was held at the Meadow Valley G. C. in Middlebury, IN on June 25th. The tournament was the MSGA's fourth visit to Meadow Valley (formerly Spring Meadow Farm) over the years.

The turnout was a solid 81, extending the good turnouts for all four 2012 events.

The weather was near perfect with plenty of sunshine, low humidity and temperatures in the mid 70's. The moderate winds were sometimes a factor. The golf course was in good condition with the fairways lush and the undulating and sloping greens very tricky. Overall with handicaps, only 11 players bested par of 72 and six others matched par.

In the Individual Medal competition, Jerry Giolitto won Low Gross with a five over par 77. Roger Stevens and Eldon Miller followed with 80's while Jerry Mussatt and Ken Bisson carded 81's.

In the Low Net competition, Art Bartholomew was the overall winner with a solid six under par net 66. Doug Hepp (68) and Bruce Fisher (69) were the only other players to break net 70. Seven others were next with net 70's.

In the Skins competition, Art Bartholomew lead with three skins, while Pat Weiss, Paul Sittig and Maynard Weimer were also multiple winners with two skins each. In total, there were 18 skins in the four flights.

In the Closest-to-the-Pin contest, John Peddycord's shot on the 140 yard Hole # 4 was closest at one foot, two inches.

Congratulations to award winners in all the flights and especially to Jerry Giolitto and Art Bartholomew for winning the overall Low Gross and overall Low Net awards. A complete list of winners can be found on the Tournament Results tab.
