

Chesapeake Run G. C. Recap

June 30, 2025

The MSGA's fifth tournament of the 2025 season was played at Chesapeake Run G. C. in North Judson, IN on June 30th.

The tournament had a total of 86 players registered with 83 players finishing rounds and are included in the results. For 2025, the MSGA has continued using three sets of tees, which are Back (Gold tees), Middle (Blue tees) and Front (Green tees). Flights A & B play from the Gold tees, Flights C & D play from the Blue tees and Flights E & F play from the Green tees.

Players choose the tee of their choice: 30 played the Gold tees, 33 played the Blue and 20 played the Green. The only limitation for playing the Green tees is a player's age plus Handicap Index must be 85+.

The weather was nice for golf with sunshine, a very light breeze, and temperatures in the mid to upper 80's. The golf course was in good condition with nice tees, fairways and bunkers. The greens were much slower than normal.

Overall, the course played very normal vs. par with handicaps as eleven players bested net par of 72 while five others matched. For the 83 players, the average gross score was 89.1 with an average net score of 76.2 (4.2 over par), which was in the normal range of 3-6 over par.

In the Individual Medal competition for gross scores by flight: John Phelps, Tom Wells and Tim Swallers posted 78's in A flight, Stephen Carter, Robert Dragani and Kevin Reichard posted 83's in B flight and Tom Knoll had 77 in C flight. Gil Vayhinger, Mike Mulkey, Brian Mikel and Joe Trippel recorded 89's in D flight, Chuck Blair shot 78 in E flight, and Tom Moser shot 86 in F flight. For flights tied, the first named won the tiebreaker for gross.

In the Individual Medal competition for Net by flight, Mike Mulkey (D) and Rick Griffin ((D) led with four under par Net 68's. Robert Dragani (B), Chuck Blair (E), Bill Scully (F) and Tom Moser (F) followed with 69's. Four others recorded net 70's.

In the Skins competition, Robert Dragani (B) won 4 skins while Tom Moser (F) had 3 skins. Five others won two skins each. In total there were 43 skins for the six flights.

In the Closest-to-the-Pin contests, Mike Mulkey's shot on Hole 17 finished 1' 1" from the hole playing from 151 yards on the Blue tees.

Congratulations to the award winners. Players pick up awards at the next event they play.

After five events in the season-long Brady Cup standings, Brian Gensel leads with 803 points followed by Tom Moser with 771 points and Robert Dragani with 747 points.
